Criteria for Citizenship Grades

"O" OUTSTANDING/INDEPENDENT LEARNER

Should demonstrate 8 or more of the following criteria:

1. Arrives on time.
2. Brings textbook when requested.
3. Continues to work without direct teacher supervision.
4. Demonstrates self-control.
5. Participates actively in class activities and discussion.
6. Demonstrates a positive attitude.
7. Evaluates own performance and strives to improve.
8. Respects instructor and classmates.
9. Cooperates with teacher and classmates.
10. Volunteers to help teacher and classmates.

"S" SATISFACTORY/COMPETENT LEARNER

The student demonstrates 6 or 7 of the "outstanding" criteria.

"N" NEEDS IMPROVEMENT/CHILDHOOD LEARNER

The student demonstrates 4 or less of the "unsatisfactory" criteria.

An "N" is a warning to the student that if his/her behavior, attitude, work habits or participation do not improve, he or she could earn a "U" on the next report card.

"U" UNSATISFACTORY/PASSIVE-DEFIANT LEARNER:

The student has earned an "N", received referral[s] to the office and demonstrates 5 or more of the following criteria:

1. Tardy one or more times per week.
2. Forgets textbook when requested.
3. Is warned to stop talking or passing notes.
4. Demonstrates passive defiance.
5. Disrespects teacher or other students.
6. Is sent out of class to work in another room or in the office.
7. Is off task.
8. Needs reminding of class rules or directions.
9. Prevents self and others from learning.
10. Refuses to work.
