State Testing at Pierpont

Who: 3rd-5th graders

What: The SBAC test is an end-of-year standardized exam that is taken on computers. It assesses critical thinking, problem solving, and understanding of the Common Core State Standards in the areas of math and English Language Arts. Additionally, 5th grade students will take a life science test (not on computers) assessing understanding of the California Science Standards.

When: May 3rd through May 20th. Teachers will share their specific testing schedule in their weekly newsletters.

Where: The SBAC test will be administered on computers in the library. The 5th grade CST life science test will be administered in classrooms with paper and pencils.

Why: Standardized assessments are designed to help provide measurable data regarding student performance that can be used to improve student learning. School staff, policy makers, elected officials, and parents regularly use the data from these tests to make decisions in the best interest of our students. Data from these tests is used to provide appropriate services for students, refine teaching practice, direct funding, and provide the public with feedback regarding school performance.

What can you do to help your child prepare: Studying for these tests is not necessary. These tests assess knowledge, understanding, and application. Parents can help by:

- Ensuring students are well rested and arrive on time
- Providing a healthy breakfast, snacks and lunch
- Scheduling appointments outside of testing
- Encouraging your child to do their best
