Marine Science Week—May 22-26

This year we have been focusing on marine science in conjunction with implementing the nationally adopted Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). We have been helping our students discover meaningful, real world connections to science. Our students have enjoyed working with hands on curriculum, generously provided by our PTA. We have also had a number of field that focused on marine science throughout the year.

This month, each grade level will participate in a culminating science project that utilizes project based learning.
