STUDENTS

FOR YOUR SAFETY, REMINDER: There has been an increase in vehicle, pedestrian, and bicyclist traffic accidents on E. Main St., between MacMillian Ave. to Seaward Ave. near Ventura High School. As a reminder, please adhere to the following for crossing all the areas near Ventura High School.

- *All students crossing at an intersection need to wait for the green "WALK" signal prior to crossing. Do not start walking across the street against a red "DON'T WALK" signal. While crossing a street, do not walk between vehicles while they are stopped at an intersection.*
- *All students crossing need to walk in the designated marked cross walks ONLY. Students riding their bicycles to and from school need to ride on the right side of the roadway, with the flow of traffic. This reminder is for your safety and awareness. Failure to abide by these guidelines may result in a traffic citation. Moreover, you could be struck by a vehicle traveling in the roadway. Your safety is our primary concern.*

REMINDER ALL VHS STUDENT DRIVERS GET YOUR PARKING PERMITS TODAY: Starting Monday, September 12, 2016, if you are found parking in the student parking lot without a current 2016-2017 parking permit sticker, you will be issued a citation. TODAY, September 9, 2016, will be the last day for parking in the lower and upper parking lots without a current 2016-2017 parking permit sticker. All 12th, 11th, and 10th grade students can come to Student Services before school, break time, lunch time, or after school to get your parking permit. You can pick up a Parking Permit application at the Student Services window, or online at the VHS website.
