- Regarding Child-Find what are the steps a teacher will take when he/she recognizes something in a child that might indicate an assessment for special education should be done?
 - Steps include:
 - Notifying the school principal and school psychologist
 - With the parent permission, possibly hold an Student Study Team (SST) every student case is individual and this might not be the case for all students
 - Finally move into an official assessment evaluation

 - Training and support for teachers of students in the mild/mod program;
 accommodation information provided through the SELPA program.
