Presentation/Approval of Tentative Agreement Between the District, Ventura Unified Education Association (VUEA) and Ventura Education Support Professionals Association (VESPA) for a one-time, off schedule bonus payment of 1.5% (Action Requested)

The District, VUEA and VESPA have reached a tentative agreement for a one time, off-schedule payment to assist all district employees for the additional job-related costs incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic during the 2020-2021 school year.

This one-time, off schedule bonus payment is equal to one and one-half percent (1.5%) of the employees' annual base salary based on the 2020-2021 salary schedules. This will be paid to all district employees, including Adult Education, currently in a paid status, which includes: full-time and part-time (prorated based on employees FTE) bargaining unit members; certificated management; classified management and confidential; and contract employees and is scheduled to be paid on the March 10, 2021 supplemental payment schedule. Mid-Year retirees who retired during the 2020-2021 school year will have their payment amount prorated based on their assignment and its end date.
