CONFERENCE - EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

15.a Update on K-12 Interventions

Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services Dr. Greg Bayless, gave an update on elementary and secondary interventions. Dr. Bayless reviewed the Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) which includes Tier 1 interventions and supports that all students receive, Tier 2 specialized interventions and supports that some students receive, and Tier 3 Intensive Intervention and supports that a few students receive. Dr. Bayless noted that the types of interventions and supports can be educational, behavioral, and or related to mental health.

Dr. Soledad Molinar, Executive Director of Educational Services reviewed Elementary Interventions including types of assessments and timelines, progress monitoring, entrance and exit criteria, case data, and multilingual learner growth. Dr. Bayless along with Ms. Bobbi Powers, Director of Secondary Education, presented on Secondary Interventions. The information included data-based course placement, credit recovery, academic interventions, and prescriptive testing. Ms. Maria Elizarraras, Director of Student Support Services, shared information regarding mental health and behavior interventions available for students in TK through 12 grade. This included Social Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum for grades Tk-8, student no-contact contracts, positive behavior support plans (PBSP), school counselors, Student Assistance Program (SAP) counselors, and social workers. Lastly, Dr. Lorelle Dawes, Director of Expanded Learning, shared that the Expanded Learning Opportunity Program (ELOP) is currently at 14 VUSD Title 1 schools where over 1500 VUSD students receive academic supports and enrichment. Dr. Dawes noted that beginning in the fall of 2023, ELOP will be at 21 VUSD school sites.

15.b <u>Consideration for Acceptance of School Accountability Report Cards for the 2021-22</u> School Year Public Announcement

Dr. Greg Bayless, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, noted that the 2021-22 School Accountability Report Cards were available for review by February 1, 2023, on the VUSD

website at https://www.venturausd.org/about/school-accountability -report-cards. Dr. Bayless noted that an updated draft report card is available on the internet for parents or guardians and that hard copies are provided upon request.

Dr. Greg Bayless, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, noted that the K- 12 Schools and Adult Education Comprehensive Safety Plans for the 2022-23 school year have been submitted to the Board for review and will be brought back to the March 14 Board Meeting for approval. Dr. Bayless shared that the Comprehensive School Safety Plans will be disseminated to school sites and will be stored in an electronic version as well as a hard copy.
